

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET

PRODUCT: Dehydrated Alfalfa O.M.B. 1218-0072

APPEARANCE: Meal, Pellets, & Cubes. Usually green in color.

TOXICITY: Ingestion - Nil.
Skin contact - May cause minor irritation around eyes & nose with prolonged exposure.
Eye contact - Nil
Inhalation - Classified as nuisance dust only.

CORROSION: Non-corrosive.

FIRE RISK: Combustible when subjected to heat or open flame. Susceptible to spontaneous combustion with improper storage and or manufacture.

EXPLOSION RISK: The dust when mixed with air in a confined space can form an explosive mixture. Dust control and good housekeeping will all but eliminate the risk.

FIRE PROFILE: First sign of a fire is a strong burnt odor. The fire is usually slow burning with little or no flame and lots of white smoke.

FIRE SUPPRESSION: Use only enough water to control the fire. Remove all wet, hot, and damaged product to prevent reignition due to spontaneous combustion. The limited use of water will help to minimize the disposal problem.

HANDLING PROCEDURES: NO SMOKING Dust suppression, extraction, or ventilation is recommended.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING: A face mask that protects against nuisance dust is recommended but not required.

STORAGE CONDITIONS: Store in a cool dry place.

FIRST AID REQUIREMENTS: None. Minor skin irritation can be eliminated with soap and water in most cases.

SPILLAGE: Reuse or dispose of in the same manner as other organic feed ingredients.
